- [1] On June 16, 2022, the Community Standards and Licence Appeal Committee (the “Committee”) heard a request for postponement of the main hearing concerning a written request received by the Committee from _____ for review of an Order dated May 2, 2022 pursuant to Section 546(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c M-26.
- [2] Prior to the postponement hearing, the Committee received written submissions concerning a postponement from _____ and from representatives of the Respondent. _____ requested a different hearing date due to a conflict with a therapy medical appointment. After consultation with their legal counsel, the Respondent’s representatives indicated they were all in agreement with, and willing to accept, a postponement.
- [3] _____ indicated he would not be attending in person and the Committee has relied on his written submissions. Several representatives for the Respondent were in attendance at the postponement hearing and confirmed their consent to rescheduling the


matter to July 19, 2022. The Committee has also relied on their written submissions and oral confirmations.

Decision

[4] The hearing of the review of the Order is tabled to July 19, 2022.

[5] The postponement is granted for the following reasons:

- i)* this is a first request for postponement and is due to conflict with a therapy medical appointment;
- ii)* the Respondent consented and provided no evidence of any immediate prejudice or concern raised by the rescheduling; and,
- iii)* the parties have agreed to the rescheduled date.
